### Memorial Day

On Decoration Day thousands and tens of thousands paid fitting tribute in honor of a day almost sacred in the hearts of a truly patriotic people. In days gone by many patriots of both the North and the South wended their way to the silent cities of the dead and strewed beautiful flowers on the tombs of departed comrades. Today the ranks are decimated until few of the heroes of the Rebellion are among the living. In addition to the above named heroes we should remember the boys who defended the flag in the Spanish-American war and the heroes sleeping an eternal slumber in Flanders fields and in the land of their birth. Remember heroes of the wars previously mentioned offered their lives in order that we may enjoy civil, political and religious freedom. Let us be thankful for existing conditions. We are a free people. The fires of hatred are forever extinguished and the Mason and Dixon line is an unpleasant memory of the past. Since the Rebellion sons and grandsons of Federal and Confederate veterans have preserved American honor in Cuba, the Philippines and in France. A recollection of the past should encourage all Americans to be more loyal. The Stars and Stripes have never touched the ground on fields of battle, and if all stand by the colors in the future with the same zeal they have in the past the American eagle will scream until the last roll call in the day of judgment. In Flanders' fields the poppies blow, Between the crosses, row on row, That mark our place; and in the sky The larks, still bravely singing, fly. Scarce heard amid the guns below.

We are the dead. Short days ago We lived, felt dawn, saw sunset glow, Loved and were loved; and now we lie In Flanders' fields.

Take up our quarrel with the foe, To you from falling hands we throw The torch. Be yours to hold it high! If you break faith with us who die, We shall not sleep—tho' poppies blow In Flanders' fields.
