

Some high points in the Real Estate Broker's law in effect May 25, 1921: If you sell or trade, or offer to sell or trade, rent or offer to rent, any real estate not your own with the promise or expectation of a commission or reward you are a real estate broker in the eyes of the law. Before beginning the business of real estate you must obtain a license from the Real Estate Commissioner and furnish a bond of \$1000 to the State of Oregon for the protection of your clients, and establish and maintain an office for tranaction of business and keep your license posted in a conspicuous place therein. A licensed real estate broker is forbidden by this law to divide his commission with any one not a licensed broker. Any violations of the law by a licensed broker car ries a penalty of ferfeiture of license, and liability on his bond for any damage a client may suffer from misrepresentation or fraud, and violations of the law by any one engaging in the business of real estate broker without having first obtained a license and posted a bond, carries I penalty of a fine and impris-anment until the fine is paid.
