THE WILD BOAR'S HEAD FEAST

Animal of Woods in Early Days Provided One of the Most Popular Christmas Dishes.

IN MEDIEVAL England it was customary to commence all grand Christmas feasts by the solemn ceremony of bringing in the bear's head as the initial dish. The master cook, preceded by trumpeters and other men with bear spears and drawn falchions and pages carrying mustard, bore the smoking head aloft on a silver platter, which he deposited at the head of the table. The head was garnished and garlanded with rosemary and laurel, and a lemon, symbol of plenty, was placed between its grating chops.

To the end of her life, Queen Victoria retained the ancient custom; also in many of the public schools and universities the bear's head is still the great dish of the Christmas banquet. On such occasions every dinner place and joins in the "Boar's Song," which has been sung for centuries. The words are set to the common chant of the prose version in cathedral.
