#### PF&R RESPONDS TO SAIL-BOAT FIRE

sailboat on fire. The boat was tied to a floating dock near the middle of the Ross Island Lagoon. PF&R fireboats arrived and found fire in the sailboats cabin. The boat was unoccupied and secure when fire crews arrived.

The fire was extinguished and an investigator was called to determine the cause. A small pet dog was inside the boat and died in this fire. The Portland Fire Investigator determined that this fire was an accident. The owner left a portable propane heater running inside her boat when she left in the morning. The fire started when that heater made contact with clothing. The loss from this fire is estimated at \$1000.

#### CRIME STOPPERS FEA-TURES CASE #15-09 PORTS-MOUTH NEIGHBORHOOD ASSAULT

The Portland Police Bureau, in cooperation with Crime Stoppers of Oregon, is asking for the public's help in identifying the suspects involved in an assault and robbery in North Precinct's Portsmouth Neighborhood. During the early morning hours of February 14, 2015, 43-year-old Patrick Wheaton was walking in the area of North Fessenden Street and N Exeter Avenue when he was attacked by two suspects and knocked unconscious. Both suspects were described as white males, having slender builds, both in their twenties, with one being approximately 6'2" tall and the other being 5'10" tall. #### SUSPICIOUS DEATH INVES-TIGATION UNDERWAY AT KELLEY POINT PARK Portland Police Bureau

Late Thursday night, Feb. 19, homicide detectives booked 22-yearold Nicholas Ross Estrada into the Multnomah County Jail on charges of Murder and Unlawful Use of a Weapon. Estrada was arraigned on Friday.

On Wednesday February 18, 2015, at 3:39 p.m., North Precinct officers responded to Kelley Point Park on the report of a missing person. Officers spoke with a 22-year-old male who told police his 22-year-old girlfriend went missing sometime overnight while they were camping in the park on the bank of the Willamette River. Officers checking the area did not locate the missing woman but due to some suspicious circumstances, officers asked for Homicide detectives and Criminalists from the Forensic Evidence Division to respond and assist with the investigation. On Feb. 20 Multnomah County Sheriff's Office divers located the 22-year-old woman deceased in the river. The Oregon State Medical Examiner will conduct an autopsy to determine the cause of death.

Updates will be provided when they become available. The woman's name will be released after the autopsy and family notifications have been made.

#### **POLICE INVESTIGATING SHOOTING IN PIEDMONT** Portland Police Bureau

February 19th, 2015 10:58AM On Thursday February 19, 2015, at 5:16 a.m., North Precinct officers responded to the intersection of Northeast Cleveland Avenue and Dekum Street on the report gunshots heard in the area. Officers arrived in the area and located two vehicles damaged by gunfire. The vehicles were unoccupied and parked on Northeast Dekum Street, between Cleveland and Rodney Avenues. Officers contacted the vehicle owners who told police they heard gunshots but did not see anyone shooting. A witness told police a van or SUV drove down the street at approximately the same time as the shooting but its unclear if the shooting came from the vehicle. The Portland Police Bureau Gang Enforcement Team and Gun Task Force are continuing to actively investigate gang and gun crimes in the City of Portland. #### GATING REPORTED SEX-UAL ASSAULT N. PORTLAND

Portland Police Bureau February 17th, 2015 5:28 PM On Sunday February 15, 2015, at 4:35 a.m., North Precinct officers responded to the report of a sexual assault at a residence near North Portsmouth Avenue and Willamette Boulevard in the University Park Neighborhood.

Officers arrived in the area and contacted the 20-year-old female victim. The victim told police that she left a party earlier in the evening and was walking home but got lost and was picked up by what she thought was a taxi somewhere near North Columbia Boulevard.

The victim reported to police that the driver sexually assaulted her before dropping her off near her home. The victim did not require immediate medical attention.

The victim described the suspect as a male Hispanic or Middle Eastern in his 40s, black hair and spoke with an accent. There is no vehicle description and no information if it is a legitimate taxi service. The Portland Police Bureau would like to remind community members that reports of this nature fortunately are a rare occurrence. Anyone with information about this incident is encouraged to contact Sex Crimes Unit detectives at (503) 823-0400. The Portland Police Bureau collaborates with government agencies and community organizations that provide access to advocacy services to victims of sexual assaults.
