shooting. During the course of this investigation officers learned that the victim had become involved in a disturbance and was stabbed. A friend of the victim was armed and fired a round from his gun to scare off the individuals who had stabbed the victim. This person lost control of the firearm which was recovered by the either the suspect or individual associated with the suspect. This group fled, firing another round from the gun in an unknown direction. Officers continue to investigate this incident. The victim's wounds are non-life-threatening and he is recovering at an area hospital.

###Original Message###

On February 14, 2015 at 8:39 p.m., North Precinct officers received a call stating that an individual had been shot in the area of N.E. Marine Drive and N.E. 2nd Avenue. Officers arrived and located an individual with a wound consistent with a gun shot in his back. Officers secured the area, obtained medical assistance for the injured individual and began an investigation. As the investigation developed officers learned that while at least one gunshot had been fired at the incident, the injuries to the victim may have been caused by a knife. The victim, suffering non-life-threatening wounds, is currently being treated and investigators hope to gather more information on the nature of his wounds shortly. While it is early in the investigation officers do not

believe this incident is gang-related. The investigation is still ongoing.

GANG ENFORCEMENT TEAM RESPONDS TO NE 18 & ROSA PARKS WAY

On Friday February 13, 2014, at 3:05 p.m., North Precinct and Gang Enforcement Team officers responded to the area of Northeast 18th Avenue and Rosa Parks Way on the report of multiple gunshots heard in the area. Officers arrived in the area and located damage from gunfire to a residence in 6400 Northeast 18th Avenue. Witnesses described a vehicle stopped on the corner and a suspect firing at the vehicle. The vehicle sped out of the area and the suspect ran away from the scene. The vehicle is described as a green smaller car and the suspect on foot is described as an African American male in his late 20s or early 30s, wearing all black clothing, carrying a gun as he ran northbound on 17th Avenue from Highland Street. A gunshot victim was taken by private vehicle to Legacy Emanuel Medical Center. At this point, the victim's condition is not known. The Portland Police Bureau Gang Enforcement Team and Gun Task Force are continuing to actively investigate gang and gun crimes in the City of Portland. 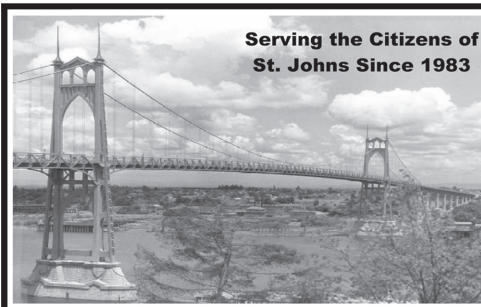
