TWO SHOT IN CONCORDIA **NEIGHBORHOOD**

On Sunday April 5, 2015, at 2:33 a.m., North Precinct officers responded to the report of a shooting at NE 28th Ave. and Alberta St. Officers arrived and located two gunshot victims, a male and a female. Both were transported to Portland hospitals for treatment to non-life-threatening gunshot wounds. Officers located evidence of gunfire on NE 27th and a crashed vehicle at NE 28th Avenue and Alberta. Preliminary information to police indicates that the two victims, along with a third person, left a neighborhood bar and got in their car to leave when an unknown suspect fired several rounds into the vehicle as it started to drive away. The vehicle crashed and all three occupants got out to run, two of them with gunshot wounds. The third occupant left the area and has not been located nor has called the police. At this point, there is no available suspect information. The Gang Enforcement Team is responding to investigate the shooting as possibly being gang-related. 
DEADLY SHOOTING INVES-TIGATION UNDERWAY IN ELIOT NEIGHBORHOOD
