TWO SHOT IN CONCORDIA NEIGHBORHOOD

On Sunday April 5, 2015, at 2:33 a.m., North Precinct officers responded to the report of a shooting at NE 28th Ave. and Alberta St. Officers arrived and located two gunshot victims, a male and a female. Both were transported to Portland hospitals for treatment to non-life-threatening gunshot wounds. Officers located evidence of gunfire on NE 27th and a crashed vehicle at NE 28th Avenue and Alberta. Preliminary information to police indicates that the two victims, along with a third person, left a neighborhood bar and got in their car to leave when an unknown suspect fired several rounds into the vehicle as it started to drive away. The vehicle crashed and all three occupants got out to run, two of them with gunshot wounds. The third occupant left the area and has not been located nor has called the police. At this point, there is no available suspect information. The Gang Enforcement Team is responding to investigate the shooting as possibly being gang-related. On Monday April 6, 2015, at 1:33 p.m., North Precinct officers responded to the Key Bank branch, located at 6815 N Lombard, on the report of a robbery. Officers arrived in the area and contacted bank employees who told police that the suspect walked up to a teller and demanded money. After obtaining an undisclosed amount of cash, the suspect left the bank and was last seen walking northbound on Heppner Avenue. Several officers checked the area but did not locate anyone matching the suspect's description. The suspect was described as a Hispanic male in his late-30s, 6'2" tall, medium build, wearing a white baseball cap, red sweater and unknown-colored pants. 17-YEAR-OLD STABBED AT NEW COLUMBIA

On Saturday March 28, 2015, at 8:46 p.m., North Precinct and Gang Enforcement Team (GET) officers responded to the 8900 block of N Newman Ave on the report of a stabbing. Officers and medical personnel arrived and located the 17-year-old male victim who was suffering from a stab wound. Medical personnel transported the victim by ambulance to a Portland hospital. His injuries are not believed to be life-threatening. Officers talked to several witnesses who told police that a group of 7-10 African American males wearing red clothing were involved in the stabbing. DEADLY SHOOTING INVESTIGATION UNDERWAY IN ELIOT NEIGHBORHOOD

On Saturday March 28, 2015, at 1:09 a.m., North Precinct officers responded to the report of a shooting at a residence on NE Morris Street, between Williams and Rodney Avenues. Officers arrived and medical personnel arrived and found an adult male in the front yard, deceased from an apparent gunshot wound. Officers began

talking with several people at the residence, including another adult male who was involved in the shooting. At this point in the investigation, there are no suspects outstanding and there does not appear to be any risk to the community. Homicide detectives and Criminalists from the Forensic Evidence Division are responding to begin a death investigation.
