Portland Harbor Superfund site
Portland Harbor is the 11 mile stretch of the lower Willamette River between the Broadway Bridge and Sauvie Island. More than a century of use has left areas of Portland Harbor polluted with hazardous substances. Because of the risk to people and the environment from the pollution, in 2000 the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency named Portland Harbor a Superfund Site, making it eligible for funding for cleanup. In 2016, EPA anticipates reaching a very important milestone – the proposed cleanup plan for Portland Harbor.

Positively partnering for a cleaner river
Concerned people from Portland and surrounding areas have been constructively engaging with EPA to develop positive ways the community can learn the facts, be involved, and be prepared to submit comments on the proposed cleanup plan for Portland Harbor. Until then, there are ways the community can stay engaged. The Community Café, Portland Harbor Workshops sponsored by EPA, and monthly Community Advisory Group meetings are activities to stay informed.

The Willamette River Revival is a free, one-day community-based festival to celebrate and reconnect with the lower Willamette River and its imminent clean up. The Portland Harbor Community Advisory Group, Cathedral Park Neighborhood Assn & Portland Harbor Comm. Coalition have joined forces to organize the event. Info. will be offered through tabling by environmental groups, science demos, storytelling and cultural perspective sharing from the native American community and other ethnic groups. The event is strongly community oriented with an emphasis on the river as the commons and the need for safer, healthier conditions for citizens and river-dependent animals. A central feature of the event is a traditional native American salmon bake hosted by the Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde starting at noon. Tribal members will offer drumming and cultural sharing about the ritual and the river system. Later live music gets underway with outstanding string bands, the Puddletown Ramblers and Cascade Crescendo, as well as other well known groups including the rapper Decora. A beer garden will be hosted by Occidental Brewery. There will be a performance by the Aztec Dancers, a children's dance troupe from Hispanic tradition, native American craft demos, food and drink vendors, guided walks, storytelling and other activities. All are welcome. Tabling is free with approval.
