### SUSPECT ARRESTED AFTER LEADING POLICE ON 2 TRAF-FIC PURSUITS IN 2 DAYS

On Tuesday July 28, 2015, at approximately 6:30 p.m., North Precinct officers were engaged in a short traffic pursuit in the area of Pier Park. The pursuit was short in duration and low speed, ending when the driver ran from the vehicle into Pier Park. The suspect tripped as he ran, which allowed officers to get close to him and take him into custody. 19-year-old Austin Wilfong was booked into the Multnomah County Jail on charges of Attempt to Elude by Vehicle (two counts), Interfering with a Peace Officer (two counts), Reckless Driving, Attempt to Elude on Foot, and Criminal Mischief in the Second Degree. Wilfong engaged police in a traffic pursuit on Monday July 27 also, after North Precinct officers responded to the report of a disturbance at a home in the 7100 block of North Hodge. Due to Wilfong's reckless driving and his known identity, officers discontinued pursuing him on Monday.

1962 - 2015


