### NORTH OFFICERS RESPOND TO SHOOTING

Late August 7, 2015 at 11:52 p.m., North Precinct officers received a call of a possible shooting at the Q-Center at 4115 N. Mississippi Ave. Officers responded to the location and found a large number of young adults outside who had been at a social event at the location. Officers were able to determine that a fight had broken out inside the location which appeared to have resulted in shots being fired both inside and outside the location. Investigators learned that an individual was shot during this incident. The victim, a 16-year-old male, suffered a non-life-threatening wound and was treated at an area hospital. The Gang Violence Response Team is responded to assist with the investigation.

### CRASH INVOLVING A MOTORCYCLE VERSUS TRUCK IN NORTH PORTLAND

The morning, August 9, 2015, at 2:41 a.m., North Precinct officers responding to a suspicious person call near North Williams Avenue and North Monroe Street came upon an unrelated crash involving a motorcycle and a delivery truck. Officers began assisting with the crash. Medical units arrived and also began assisting the victim. Officers learned that the delivery truck was heading north bound on N. Williams Avenue and took a left turn onto N. Monroe Street when it collided with a motorcycle. Early August 11 the motorcycle rider died of injuries suffered during the crash. He has been identified as 32-year-old Robert Gabriel. His passenger, 29-year-old Tasheena Kuehl, remains in the hospital and is expected to survive.

### OFFICERS RESPOND TO CRASH INVOLVING A VEHICLE & PEDESTRIAN

The Major Crash Team has con-

cluded that the pedestrian fell and was lying in the roadway prior to being struck. The involved motorist swerved to avoid the pedestrian, striking a curb. The motorist stopped and contacted 911 about the person lying in the road, then left the scene. The motorist returned to the scene after learning that the pedestrian had been hit. The motorist is cooperating with investigators. Alcohol is not believed to be a factor. The pedestrian suffered life-threatening injuries and is being treated at an area hospital.
