a Portland hospital. He is expected to survive his injuries. Officers spoke to the victim as well as a female passenger and learned that the shooting occurred at North Charleston Avenue and North Swenson Street (approximately 3 miles away). Officers responded to that location and found evidence of gunfire. The victim injured in Wednesday night’s shooting has been identified as 27-year-old Alexander Ray English. English’s injuries were not life-threatening. At the time of the shooting, English was driving his car with his wife and three small children. The only suspect information is that the shooter was a male wearing a gray or white tank top and may have been accompanied by another person as they ran South on North Charleston Avenue after the shooting. 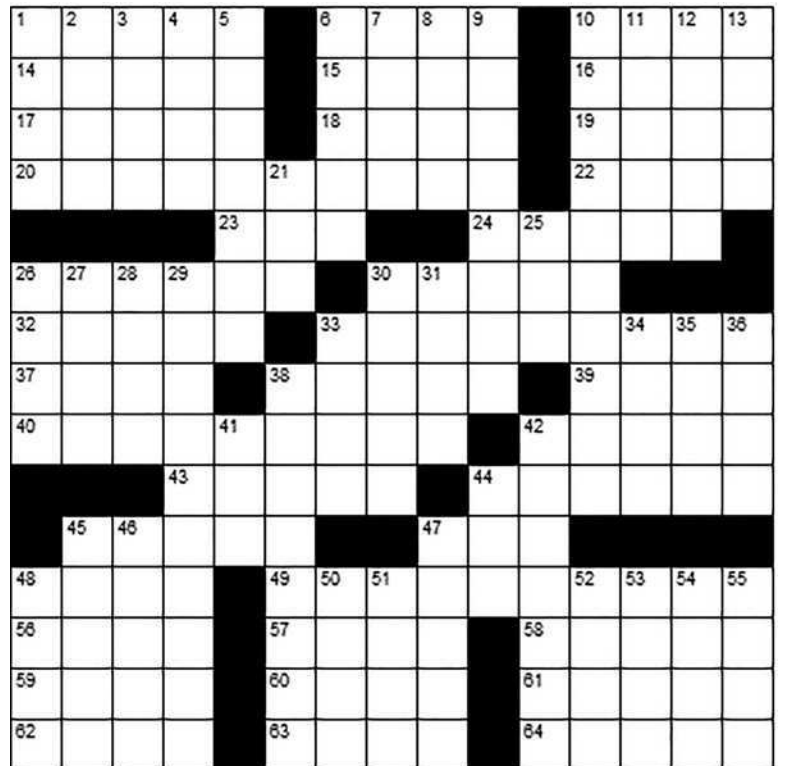
### Portland Fire Reports: PORTLAND FIRE RESPONDS TO WILD LAND FIRE IN

Firefighters were dispatched to a fire below the 6800 block of N. Willamette Blvd. at 17:56 pm. The fire originated on the river-side of the train tracks below the Bluff. The fire was approximately 100 x 100 feet when the first engines arrived. Firefighters quickly knocked down the bulk of the fire, while secondary crews arrived to put out the remaining “spot” fires. No one was injured during this incident and the cause is under investigation.
