a Portland hospital. He is expected to survive his injuries. Officers spoke to the victim as well as a female passenger and learned that the shooting occurred at North Charleston Avenue and North Swenson Street (approximately 3 miles away). Officers responded to that location and found evidence of gunfire. The victim injured in Wednesday night's shooting has been identified as 27-year-old Alexander Ray English. English's injuries were not life-threatening. At the time of the shooting, English was driving his car with his wife and three small children. The only suspect information is that the shooter was a male wearing a gray or white tank top and may have been accompanied by another person as they ran South on North Charleston Avenue after the shooting.
