PORTLAND FIRE AND RESCUE RESPONDED TO A TWO ALARM FIRE AT ROOSEVELT HI SCHOOL

The alarm came in at 7:06PM. Upon arrival crews noted dark smoke visible from the roof of the building and from the third story windows of the gymnasium. At 7:11PM Command called a second alarm. Roosevelt High School is currently under construction and this portion of the school was not in use. Crews on scene gained access to the gymnasium and extinguished the fire. Crews encountered heavy smoke and low amounts of heat. The fire did not extend to any other parts of the school. The gymnasium is approximately 150'X75' and the fire was contained to a materials pile of about 20'X10' adjacent to the stage.

Chief of staff for Portland Public Schools Amanda Whalen and other school administrators were on scene, and noted that the rest of the school was unaffected by the smoke. There were no injuries

reported at this time. The fire is currently being investigated as an arson.

MAN EXPOSES HIMSELF TO 10-YEAR-OLD GIRL IN ARBOR LODGE NEIGHBORHOOD IN NORTH PORTLAND

On Tuesday September 8, 2015, at 3:51 p.m., North Precinct officers responded to the report that a man exposed himself to a 10-year-old girl in the area of North Denver Avenue and Bryant Street. Officers spoke with the girl and her mother and learned that the girl was walking home from Chief Joseph School, located at 2409 North Saratoga Street, when she was contacted by a man riding a bicycle. The suspect asked her some questions then exposed his penis to her as he rode his bicycle. The girl ran home and told her mother, who called police. The suspect is described as a white male in his 30s, medium to thin build, brown hair, mustache, wearing a blue t-shirt, blue base-

ball hat, shorts, and black athletic shoes. The bicycle was described as a mountain bike with a rack and saddlebags. Several officers checked the area but did not locate anyone matching the suspect's description. There is an unconfirmed report that a similar incident happened near De La Salle North Catholic High School, located at 7528 North Fenwick Avenue, in the Kenton Neighborhood. If any residents in the area of this incident have residential surveillance cameras, investigators are asking them to check recordings for any possible images of the suspect. Anyone seeing or encountering this suspect should immediately call 9-1-1.

UPDATE:

On Sept. 10, 2015 Officers booked 29-year-old Eric Garcia into the Multnomah County Jail on three counts of Public Indecency and three counts of Endangering a Minor. He will be arraigned on Friday. Officers contacted Garcia this morning in the Kenton Neighborhood and believed he matched the description of the suspect in two reported incidents where he rode his bicycle up to young girls and exposed himself. The second victim is a 14-year-old girl and the incident occurred near De La Salle North Catholic High School. Officers continued to investigate and developed probable cause to arrest Garcia, later locating him outside his residence in the 2000 block of North Kilpatrick Street and taking him into custody without incident. Officers believe there is at least one more victim in the neighborhood who has not made a report to police.

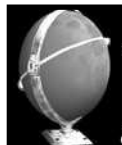
Avenue and Willamette Boulevard after the report that a suspect stole marijuana from the Smoke Buddy mobile marijuana cart. As officers were responding to the scene they learned that an African American male suspect fled the area in dark-colored SUV. Officers arrived and learned that a second suspect was detained by the cart operator so she was taken into custody. The second suspect is a 34-year-old female. Officers learned that the victim was opening up the trailer for the day when he saw the unidentified male suspect and the female suspect walking towards the trailer. The male suspect tried to open the trailer door with the victim inside and a struggle ensued. The male suspect displayed a knife and ran over to the trailer owner's vehicle, where the second owner was seated inside. The male suspect grabbed some items from the trunk of her vehicle while the female suspect jumped on the victim's back. The victim was able to get her off of his back but she grabbed a stick and began swinging at him. The victim grabbed his own stick and fought her and the male suspect off and the male suspect ran to the vehicle and drove away, leaving the female suspect behind. The victim did not receive any notable injuries during the robbery.

UPDATE:

34-year-old Kelly Foster Green was booked into the Multnomah County Jail on charges of Robbery in the First Degree and Robbery in the Second Degree. She was arraigned on Friday.
