On Monday November 23, 2015, at 6:40 a.m., North Precinct officers responded to the report of a robbery at gunpoint at Burger King, located at 632 NE Weidler. Officers arrived in the area and contacted employees who told police that the suspect entered the restaurant, armed with a handgun, and demanded money. After obtaining an undisclosed amount of cash the suspect left without incident. Several officers searched the neighborhood but did not locate anyone matching the suspect's description. The suspect is described as an African American male in his 30s or 40s, 5'9" to 6'00 tall, wearing dark clothing. Anyone with information is asked to contact Robbery detectives at 503-823-0405.

On Sunday Nov. 22, 2015, at 9:05 a.m., North Precinct officers responded to the report of an armed robbery at the Jack in the Box, located at NE Martin Luther King JR Blvd and Columbia Blvd. Officers arrived in the area and contacted employees who told police that the suspect entered the

restaurant, armed with a handgun, and demanded money from the employees. After obtaining an undisclosed amount of cash, the suspect left the restaurant without incident. Several officers searched the neighborhood but did not locate anyone matching the suspect's description. The suspect is described as an African American male in his 40s wearing black clothing. Anyone with information about this incident is asked to contact Robbery detectives at 503-823-0405.

To date there have been 173 Gang Violence Response Team callouts in 2015. At this point last year there had been 104 callouts and for the entire year 109.

Anyone with information about either shooting is asked to call the Police Non-Emergency Line at 503-823-3333 or the Tactical Operations Division at 503-823-4106. The Portland Police Bureau works closely with Enough is Enough PDX, a community-led campaign aimed at encouraging people to take a stand against gang violence in the area. 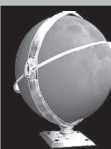
