The oat crop is 100,000,000 bushels more than last year.

C., the supreme court affirmed the decision of the circuit court of California, refusing a writ of habeas corpus to Theodore Durrant, under sentence of death DAVIDSON'S for the murder of Miss Blanche Lamont of San Francisco, in April, 1895. 
