MR. KINCAID'S VIEWS.

Secretary of State Harrison R. Kincaid, elected four years ago on the republican ticket, but recently re-nominated for the office by the "union of forces" at Portland writes, in accepting the nomination, to those who conferred the honor upon him, as follows:

"Please accept my sincere thanks for the nomination for re-election as secretary of state by three state conventions, representing the people's party, the democratic party and the silver-republican party of Oregon. I trust that the confidence reposed in me by the bimetalists of Oregon, whom you represent, will never be betrayed.

Notwithstanding the frantic efforts of the gold-standard press, assisted by some of the alleged leaders of the populist party, a satisfactory union of the reform forces in Oregon has been accomplished and a ticket nominated.
