



Cottonseed Meal.

The hulls of cotton seed are exceedingly hard to digest. For this the cottonseed meal that contains many of the black specks which are parts of the hull should never be fed to young stock, or even to older stock, unless it has been gradually accustomed to its use. The meal free from specks is very rich food, and especially in the material for furnishing strength. It needs to be fed with some divisor that contains little nutrition, and for this purpose grain straw is better than hay, as it is less likely to cloy the animal.


