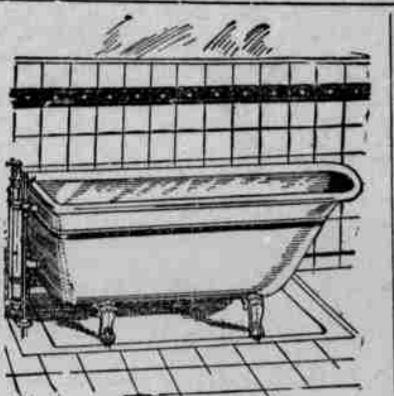

The management of the Oregon City Y. M. C. A. cordially invite the attention of the public to a statement of the labor, material and expenditures of the new building and the present financial condition of the institution.

The building is 100 ft. in length, 48 ft. wide, and fronts directly on Main Street, Corner posts on north side are 36 ft., on south side 21 ft. The basement is 22 ft. wide, 100 ft. long, and 15 ft. deep below the side-walk, and is at present fitted up complete with men's bath rooms with water system, and foundation for bowling alley. On the gymnasium floor are three bright rooms in front for reading room and parlor, back of these is the gymnasium hall, 48 x 70 ft., surrounded by a handsome gallery and at the rear of the gymnasium are ladies' apartments, finished in hard oil with showers and complete water system. The building rests on a stone and cement wall 3 x 3 ft. under the entire north side. A stone wall 3 ft. wide and 16 ft. high also extends 35 feet along the east end, the remaining east end, entire south side and west end resting upon a natural ledge of solid rock.

Resources available in construction of building: Pledges, boys and business men (cash) \$ 500 Proceeds city canvas (cash) 440 Labor contributed 50 990

From the foregoing statement it is apparent that the total valuation of the Y. M. C. A. property is \$320 and the present indebtedness, including price of lot and old indebtedness, amount to \$1700. Deducting old debt and price of lot from above amount and there remains less than \$700 unpledged of the \$2300 put into the building. The board has borrowed this \$700 in its personal notes to complete the building, but is gratified at this showing and most sincerely appreciates the favor and kindly considerations received from the public, and with the fair support and aid of the public hereafter the permanent establishment of the institution is assured.
