EDITORIAL PARAGRAPHS.

THE Filipinos will be capable of self-government long before they are ready for citizenship in the United States.

If the republican candidate for governor of Ohio was placed on record against trusts by his platform, while Senator Hanna cannot see anything bad about them, there would appear on the face of things to be some lack of harmony between these two Ohio statesmen.

It would seem that by this time Mr. McKinley must understand the popular feeling regarding the scandalous navy department treatment of the man who smashed the dons at Santiago.

Nobody has yet proposed the erection of a triumphal arch for Otis, though the people would doubtless be glad to erect a dozen if the president would only order him home.

Senator Hanna has begun his scramble for funds quite early this campaign. He is now giving the federal office holders pointers on prosperity and how they can best retain it.

The president should familiarize himself with the great truths set forth in the Declaration of Independence and apply them to his policy.

Last fall republican organizations sent circulars to postmasters in many states, but the postmaster general ordered all postmasters to put up in their offices a notice to employes that they need not contribute and would not be molested if they failed to do so. Now that the Ohio republicans are asking assessments this fall, will the postmaster general repeat his order?

The administration organs at last say openly that nothing will be done to avert war in the Transvaal that would be disagreeable to England.

President McKinley points with pride to an increase of territory as if it was due to him, but fails to mention the increase of the national debt, the increase in the internal revenue taxes and the increase in the number of trusts.

The protective tariff converts the trusts—the consolidation of many establishments—into a monopoly of the worst sort, by making a closed field in which trusts may put up prices unreasonably. The Dingley tariff destroys competition from abroad and the trust destroys it at home, so the consumer is forced to pay the prices that will provide the dividends upon the watered stock.

The government of the United States has temporarily abdicated its functions at Washington and gone off upon a political stumping tour throughout the West. So many official "spellbinders" never before left the capital in a body to hunt for votes. It is a great political minstrel show, the like of which it is to be hoped we shall not soon see again.

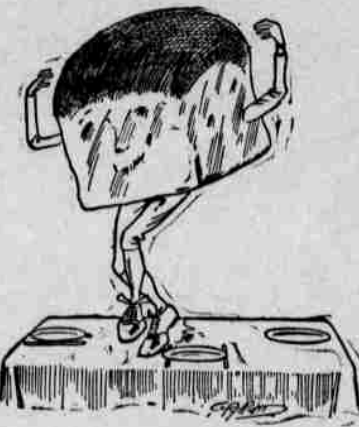
