with Dr. J. W. Norris and the firm enjoy the confidence and esteem of the community to an unlimited degree.

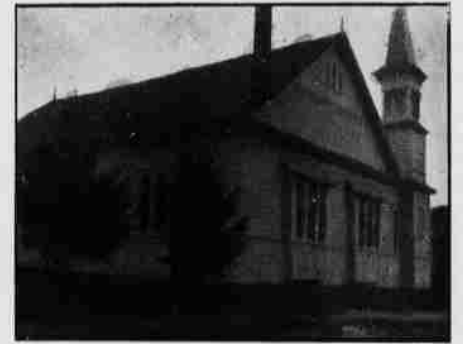
DR. C. A. STUART
