The dispatches indicate republican victories for the candidates throughout the state. Indications are for Chamberlain's election for governor.

Thursday, June 5.

The latest returns indicate that Furnish may be elected governor, as the later returns from country precincts appear to be in his favor. If elected, it will only be by a small majority. The other republicans on the state and congressional tickets are elected by large majorities. All the republicans on the Multnomah county and city ticket are elected, except the citizen candidates, O'Donnell for assessor, and Werdin for city treasurer. The sheriff is in doubt.

The latest count indicates that Chamberlain is still 341 ahead.

Linn county went democratic, and several democrats were elected in other counties.
