Of these the Republicans have already carried Ohio and lost Maryland. Of the twenty-one others the Republicans may be counted as fairly sure of Michigan. Minnesota, Maine, Connecticut, Massachusetts, North Dakota, Vermont and Pennsylvania, eight in all, or nine with Ohio, already secured. This leaves three to get from such states of Republican tendency as Rhode Island, Indiana. New Jersey and West Viriginia, and such debatable states as Delawase, Cali fornia, Wyoming, New York, Nebraska, Washington, Utah and Nevada.

The Democratic 1905 seats are from such sure strongholds as Tennessee. Missouri, Texas, Virginia, Mississippi and Florida, with Montana fairly wedled to Democracy. There would seem to be little or no hope for the Republicans to increase their majority in the upper House through next year's elect-ions, and it is evident that they must do a good deal of active campaigning to hold their present control.




