The Shannon Brothers have started up their saw mill and are running it in full blast.

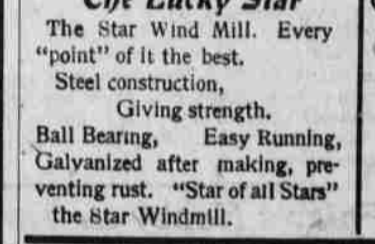
Miss Louisa Stiner, who was spending a few days in Portland with friends, returned home Monday.

I know most people, but somehow I don't seem to recollect Timbuctoo. But I do not know that he is not a Sunday school boy, or he would be more careful not to say such things.

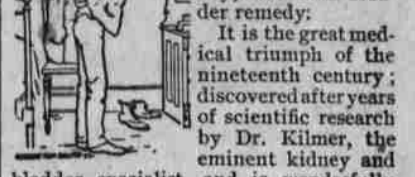
