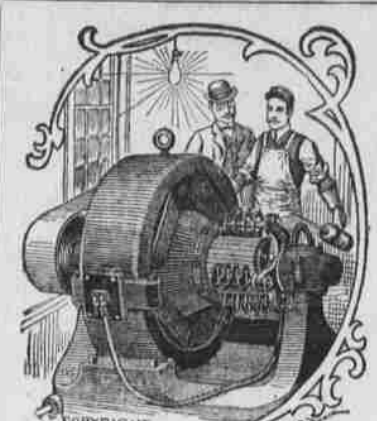
**Young Men Waive Examination.**

Herman Schuler and John Landerman, the young men who were arrested Tuesday for enticing two 14-year-old girls from their homes in this city, appeared before the justice of the peace yesterday and waived their examination. The case will be tried in the circuit court.

**Will Be Tried in Circuit Court.**

Henry Roos and Ernest Matthis were arraigned Friday before Justice Livy Stipp, charged with selling liquor to minors. The saloon men waived examination and will have their trial in regular order in the circuit court.

In the crusade just ended in which open gambling was closed the officials recognize the selling of liquor to boys and girls to be the most important feature and the one most detrimental to the welfare of the city. The authorities are determined to stop this, and they are backed up by the law-abiding saloonmen, who have to bear the blame for the acts of a few men. One saloon in the city recently had its license revoked and a strong effort will be made to have this done in every instance where boys under age buy liquor.
