But the people should not allow themselves to fall into the belief that all that is reprehensible in Clackamas county politics is centered in a single man. The "bunch" that have ridden with a high hand would gladly have one of their number bear the odium of the transgressions and sins of all. In this they add cowardice to the long list of their shortcomings and exhibit the characteristics of the despised Judas.

At a most inopportune time the press has much to say. As is too frequently the case it has been peculiarly silent during most of the time that the better element has been fighting for better political conditions. The Oregonian, a publication that knew the situation and lent its influence to perpetuate it, comes limping in with its gibes and lashings at the eleventh hour. The Evening Telegram was readily enlisted in the schemes of the coterie of Clackamas county politicians who manipulated politics for what there is in it. Such vendors of news hurriedly sidestepped to align themselves with the element of decency that they may more effectively plan the overthrow.

The verdict of the June election was not against one but against all of the plotters against honest government, for the requirement of personal gain. Locally they are known. There will be more to be said when one of these seeks to profit by his colleague's overthrow.

MILLING COMPANY IN NEW QUARTERS.

The Oregon City Planing Mill Co. has moved into its new and commodious quarters. This institution will be a factor in the city's prosperity. It is a substantial advantage to the county. The output of the numerous country sawmills will find a market here and these concerns will not be dependent on the uncertain local demand.

Splendid success seems to be in store for the new company. It is backed by local capital and its success will be the signal for other local capitalists to branch out. The community's handicap has been the inertia of local capital.

Undoubtedly the good will and best wishes of the community will be with the new institution. Such manufacturing enterprises are a public benefit, the men back of them are, to a certain extent, public benefactors, and as some of them are engaged in other pursuits the public can at times show

appreciation of their enterprise in a substantial manner.

BRYAN IN 1908?

There is at least an attempted house-cleaning in the Nation. The big trusts are squirming, a rate bill is worrying the railroads, the meat packing establishments are terror-stricken. Is the Republican party to have credit for what President Roosevelt is forcing inch by inch from it? This will be the paramount question in the coming presidential election. This will be the question in the minds of the people, even though political

manipulators may raise other issues in the hope of diverting the public mind. Will there be a common call for William Jennings Bryan as the man to continue the battle for the people, begun by Roosevelt? Such are the indications of the present time.

RAN BEHIND HIS TICKET.

Labor Commissioner Hoff Fell Off in Clackamas Co. With Good Reason.

Labor Commissioner O. P. Hoff was in the city Saturday and discovered an error in the official ballot for Clackamas county that explained away the fact that he is minus several hundred votes that he should have had. Mr.

Hoff read the published reports of the official vote of Clackamas county several days ago and was surprised to learn that W. S. Richards, the Socialist candidate for labor commissioner, had received 1533 votes in Clackamas county, while with no other opposition than the Socialists named, Mr. Hoff himself scored 2076 votes against 8177 for Superintendent of Public Instruction J. H. Ackerman, who was not only opposed by a Socialist but a Prohibitionist as well. He accordingly came to the city and made inquiries and it was found upon investigation, that through somebody's error, Mr. Richards had been placed on the Clackamas county ballot as a Democrat and not as a Socialist. Naturally he received the Democratic vote in Clackamas county,

which is between 1100 and 1200, and also received the Socialist vote and a portion of the Prohibitionist vote.

As Mr. Hoff was re-elected labor commissioner by a large majority, the matter is of little moment, but he shudders to think what it might have been had the election been close and had he been defeated by a few hundred votes. In the latter instance the vote of Clackamas county would probably have been thrown out but this would not have helped Mr. Hoff, as he carried the county over Mr. Richards by a majority of 1213 votes and the local attorneys, while not having given the matter close study believe that the whole election would have been invalidated all over the state so far as labor commissioner was concerned.
