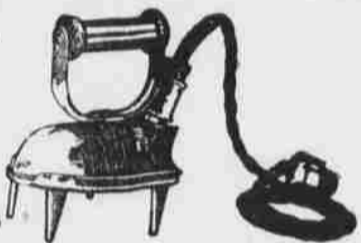

## LOWER FARE IS REQUESTED

Residents of Gladstone and Parkplace Petition Railway Company.

President H. W. Goode, of the Oregon Water Power & Railway Company, has assured a committee, composed of Judge Dimick, Harvey Cross and Judge Hayes, that he would look into the matter of reducing the fare on the electric line between this city and Gladstone. It is probable that he will communicate with the members of the committee at an early date.

The people of Gladstone and Parkplace believe they are charged too high a rate for transportation. The regular rate is 5 cents each way from Oregon City but by purchasing a book of tickets a reduction to 4 1/2 cents is secured. The people want a further reduction and ask for a round trip rate of five cents, making the fare 2 1/2 cents each way.

About two years ago the company gave the residents of the suburban towns of Gladstone and Parkplace a rate of three cents each way from Oregon City. This was very satisfactory, but one day a resident of this city attempted to ride to Meldrum's station on one of these special rate tickets. The conductor balked and the result was an encounter that culminated in the arrest and fine of the railway official.

The management of the company exacted punishment from every resident of Parkplace and Gladstone for this affair by withdrawing the special round trip rate and making the fare 4 1/2 cents.

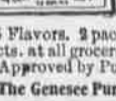
