B. Lewellen D. L. C.; thence east to the southeast corner of said claim; thence north to the southwest corner of the L. A. Lacey D. L. C.; thence east to the line between sections 16 and 17 of said township and range; thence south to the northwest corner of section 21, T. 4 S., R. 4 E.; thence east to the north east corner of said section 21; thence south two miles to northeast corner of section 33; thence west 3 miles to beginning.
