## WANDERERS WIN IN WALK

MUDDY DIAMOND AGAIN INTERFERES WITH THE NATIONAL GAME.

### DOUBLE HEADER PLAYED

Saturday's Games Lower the Standing of Local Team—Plenty of Errors.

In one of the poorest played games ever seen on a local diamond, the reorganized Albina Wanderers won their first two games of the season by defeating the Papermakers in a double header Decoration Day. The rain, which had fallen for two days previous, left the diamond in a terrible shape, which rendered good baseball impossible. Both teams hit freely but the majority of the runs were registered as the result of the numerous errors by the members of both nines. Kruger, who guards the difficult sack for the Papermakers, was sent on the bench by umpire Rankin for losing his head and throwing the ball at McBride, of the Pilgrims, thereby allowing three runs to slip in.

The visitors started the run getting in the opening chapter, and by the time that three of their side were declared "out" by his "umps," they had nine runs. Another was annexed in the third, and three in the fifth, while their last tally came in on the seventh as a result of a series of errors on the part of the Papermakers. The locals scored once in the second, twice in the fifth, three each in the sixth and seventh, and once more in the closing chapter. Taylor made his initial appearance in an Oregon City uniform at the beginning of the second game, a five inning affair, when he attempted to steal to the first department. He fell on his shoos with a vim, and made seven runs before he was replaced at the end of the second inning by Robinson.
