There were questions of far-reaching importance that came up for settlement. The "Venezuela Affair," for example, has its important place in World history.

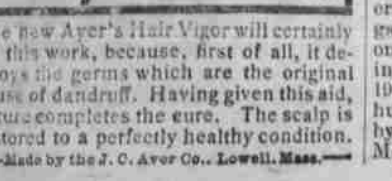
