ORDINANCE NO—

An Ordinance Regulating and Licensing Bill-Posting in Oregon City.

Oregon City does Ordain as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to post, paint, tack, hang or distribute any advertising matter, circulars, hand bills, doggers, cards, samples, sample copies or other matter, bills or doggers used to advertise patent medicine, patent articles, tobacco, shows, tent shows, circuses, theatrical performances or for any other purpose for which advertising matter, signs, tract the attention of the public without first obtaining a license therefor from the city of Oregon City, as hereinafter provided.
Any person desiring to obtain a license for such purpose shall pay to the city treasurer the sum of \$100 as an annual license fee, and shall file a receipt therefor with the city recorder. The city recorder shall thereupon issue the license herein provided for, but no license shall be issued for a less period than three months; provided that employes of any person, firm or corporation who have obtained a license as in this section, required shall not be required to procure such license.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, whether licensed or not, to post, affix, stamp, paint, nail, hang, tack or otherwise affix or cause to be done by another, any notice, placard, bill, poster or advertisement to or upon any sidewalk or crosswalk, curb, or curb-stone, lamp post, hydrant, shade tree or trees, boxes, fence, gate, gate-post or inclosure, awning or awning post, hitching post, telegraph pole, electric light or power pole or telephone pole, or for any person whether licensed or not to post, stick, stamp, or otherwise affix or cause to be done by another any notice, placard, bill, poster or advertisement upon any building, wall, or part thereof without first obtaining permission of the owner, agent or occupant of such premises, or for any person to distribute on the streets, alleys or public parks of Oregon City, by handing to or giving to pedestrians passing along or standing upon such streets, any poster, advertisement, notice, bill or placard.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful for any person to throw into or drop on or upon, or cause to be thrown or dropped in or upon any street or sidewalk any bill, poster, dogger, or other advertisement.

Section 4. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined not less than three dollars nor more than one hundred dollars, or by imprisonment in the city jail not less than three days nor more than fifty days or by both such fine and imprisonment.
