In the merchant service of Great Britain the skipper enjoys even greater power. He is not obliged to return a certificate, the only compulsion on him being the necessity to "log" the marriage in his official log book, where it may be entered between reports dealing with the vessel's provisioning, her course, the weather encountered, the ships spoken and the many other de tails of the log.-Harper's Weekly,
