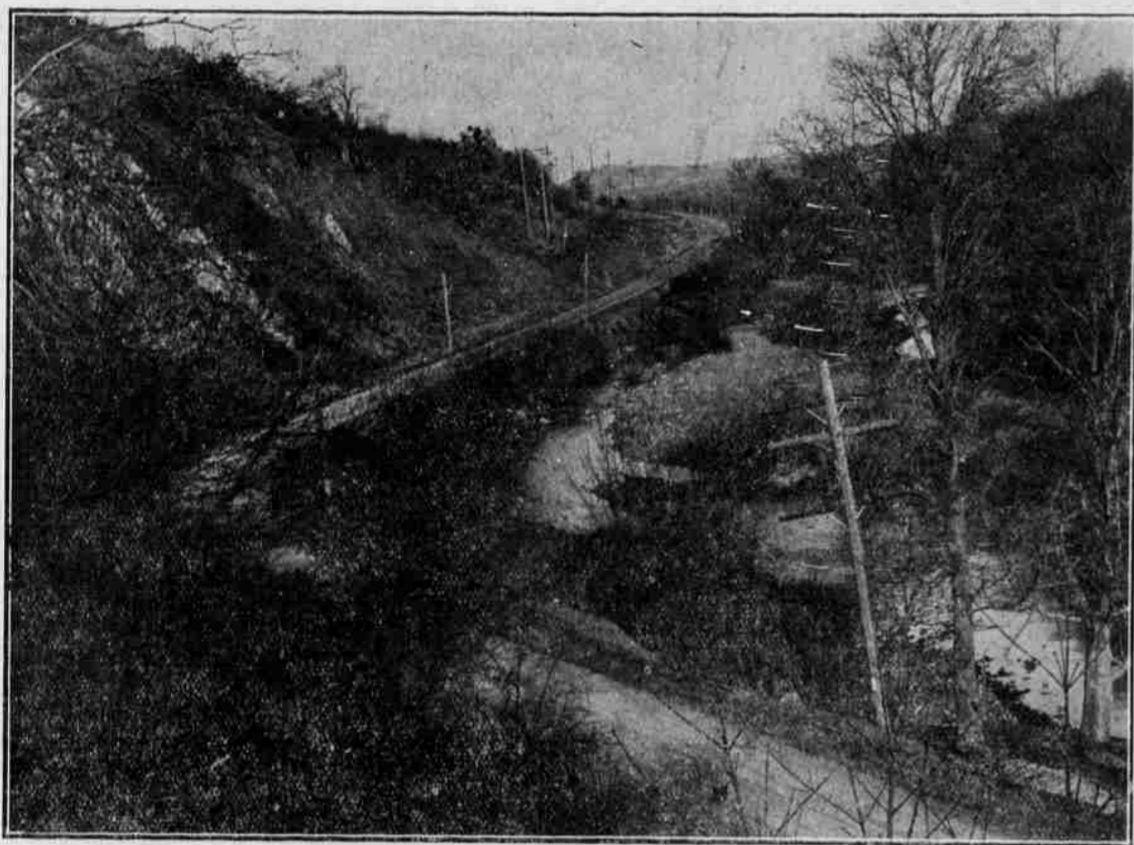


## 20 YEARS OF SUCCESSFUL EXPERIENCE

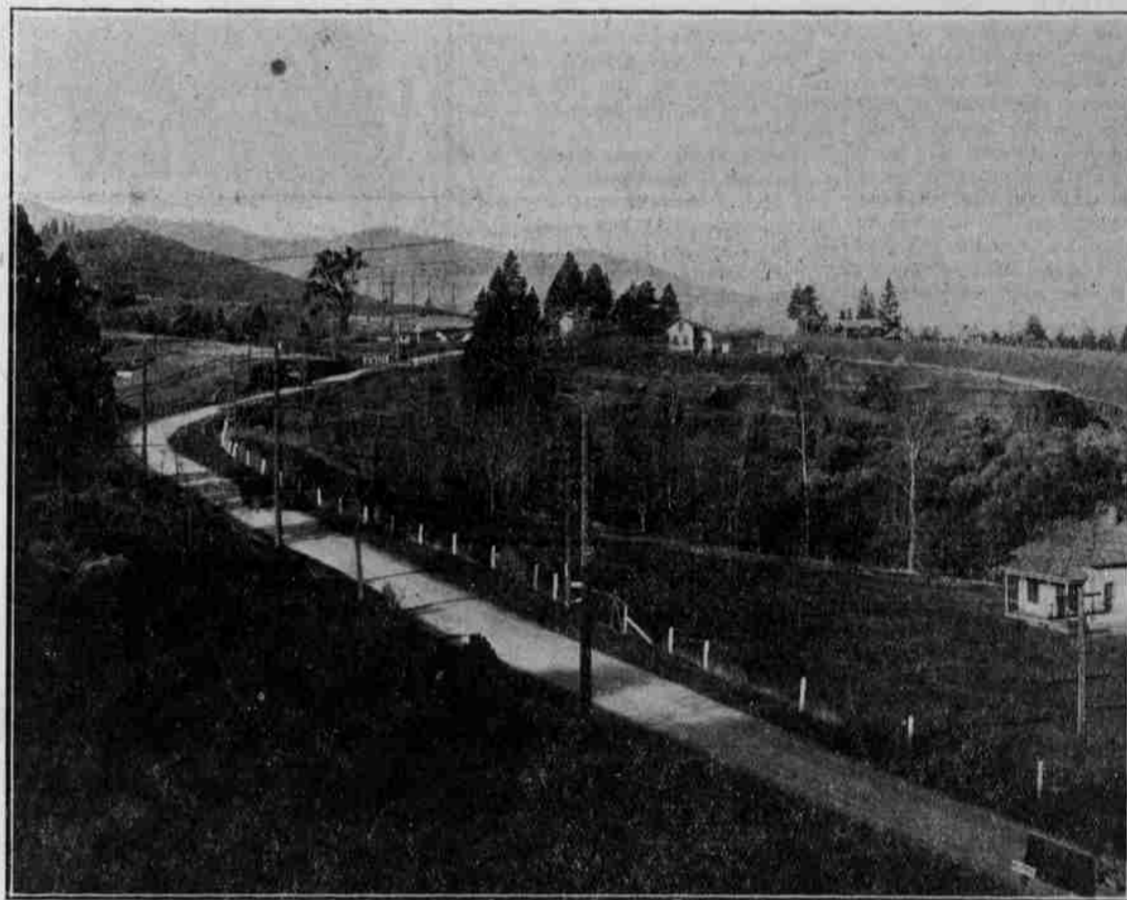
