ORDINANCE NO.

An ordinance amending ordinance No. 881 of Oregon City, Oregon, entitled "An ordinance prohibiting persons who are afflicted with certain diseases from engaging or working in certain occupations or employments whereby such diseases may be spread and declaring an emergency," passed by the council and approved by the Mayor August 19, 1921, said amend-

ment being an addition of Section 3 thereto, providing a penalty, and declaring an emergency. Oregon City does ordain as follows—Section 1. That ordinance No. 881 of Oregon City, Oregon, entitled "An ordinance prohibiting persons who are afflicted with certain diseases from engaging or working in certain occupations or employments whereby such diseases may be spread and declaring an emergency," passed by the council and approved by the Mayor August 19, 1921, be and the same hereby is amended by adding thereto section 3 as follows:—

Section 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof before the Mayor or Recorder of Oregon City, be punished by a fine not exceeding \$25.00 for each offense, or by imprisonment in the city jail for a period not exceeding 10 days, or by both such fine or imprisonment.

Section 2. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Oregon City, in this: That owing to the spread of certain diseases through the

handing and use of food and food products; dishes, etc., immediate action is necessary in order to provide measure for checking the spread of such diseases therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the council.

Read first time at a special meeting of the city council held on July 15, 1922, at 7:30 o'clock p. m., and ordered published to come up for second reading and passage at a regular meeting of the city council to be held on the 2nd day of August 1922, at 7 o'clock p. m.
