OREGON ASSESSMENT.

Eighteen Counties Have Reported their Assessment.

Of the thirty-one counties of the state, eighteen of them have made known the sum of their total taxable property. In every county—with a single exception—the total taxable is larger this year than last, and the aggregate of the footings of the eighteen counties equals almost half of the assessment of 1890.
