AN ORDINANCE establishing the grade of High Center, Washington, John Adams, Jefferson, Madison, Monroe, John Q. Adams, Jackson, Van Buren, Harrison, Polk and Taylor streets.

Oregon City does ordain as follows:

That the following be and hereby is established as the grade of the hereinafter mentioned streets, to wit:
