PRIZE ESSAYS WANTED. "The floral department of the Oregon State Horticultural Society will hold a flower show in June at Portland. The contestants are not to be more than 15 years of age.

In the institute held at Albany, the following plan of progressive work was proposed by Professor Crawford and unanimously adopted: Be it resolved by the public school teachers of Linn Co., Ore., here assembled that the time has come for a forward step in county organization for teachers.

In accordance with this sentiment be it further resolved that a committee of five be appointed, of whom the county superintendent shall be the corresponding secretary, to be known as a teachers' bureau of information for Linn county.

Said committee shall be authorized and shall have full power to buy or otherwise procure books and periodicals bearing on the subject of teaching, said books and periodicals to form a free circulating library for all teachers who enroll their names for this purpose.

In order to entitle any teacher to the benefits of this bureau she shall place his name on a roll to be provided for that purpose, and pay an annual fee of one dollar.

Members of the association are requested to study over their plan as outlined in the Western Pedagogue and see if we can adopt this or something similar into our own organization. Come prepared to take some action regarding this at our meeting at Canby, May 27.
