The ENTERPRISE last week gave the figures showing the amount of taxable property in Clackamas county, but as the books had not been completely footed up, it was impossible to give all the totals. In order to place the result of the assessor's work before our readers, here given, and compared with those of last year they make a very favorable showing relative to the growth of the county during a year not noted for advancement in material prosperity.
