Pensions and Internal Revenue.

Texas paid last year \$506,375 of internal revenue taxes and received in pensions \$905,230, South Carolina paid \$71-, 812 revenue taxes and received \$171,-129 in pensions. Tennessee contributed \$1,278,862 and drew out in pensions \$2,484,508. Alabama's revenue taxes were \$106,771; her pension receipts were \$400,-729, Arkansas paid \$95,718.86 revenue true history. She rests from her labors taxes; received in pensions, \$1,470,901.77. West Virginia's revenue tax was \$807,-588.36 and was paid in pensions \$2,158,gether paid \$784,882.29 and received pensions \$9,343,996. New York paid \$17,670,978 revenue tax and received in pensions \$11,762,490.
