Report of viewers of the J K Gribble et al, road approved and expense account ordered paid. J K Graham, Mart Robbins and C U Babcock appointed appraisers of damages.

Petition of R B Wilmot et al for a county road, granted and G W Prosser, N S Kellogg and W Wauka were appointed viewers and Chas H Isom surveyor.

Application of Jesse Hammer for relief granted and \$7 per month allowed. Petition of M B Darnall for appointment as constable in Beaver Creek precinct granted.

Petition of J V Harless et al for a road survey granted and Chas H Isom, deputy surveyor, appointed to survey.

Supervisor T J Drake ordered to repair Butte Creek bridge. Petition of E Covey for relief from costs on tax roll granted and \$2.35 ordered deducted from the amount of the total tax.
