Proceedings of the December Session—Bills Allowed.

Present—Gorden E. Hayes, judge; Elmer Dixon, clerk; G. W. Grace, sheriff; Frank Jaggard and S. F. Marks commissioners.

In the matter of the report of the viewers, G. W. Prosser, N. S. Kellogg and W. Wanka, on the R. B. Wilnot et al county road; report accepted and the expense account of \$32.20 allowed.

In the matter of the petition of A. Y. Jacobs, et al for a county road; L. A. Shipley, C. R. Noblitt and Adam Walling appointed viewers and C. H. Isom surveyor.

In the matter of the petition of E. S. Calkins et al for a county road; G. B. Seely, A. P. Ladd and Harrison Lichtenhaler appointed viewers and C. H. Isom surveyor.

In the matter of the claim of A. J. Kitzmiller for clearing on the Revenue road contract; claim of \$34.50 allowed and warrant ordered drawn for amount.

In the matter of the petition of Jesse Allen to remain where he was and receive same relief; petition granted.

In the matter of the application for relief of Mrs. G. M. Fleming; petition granted and \$8 per month allowed from December 1st, 1896.

In the matter of the petition of Mr. Oswald for relief; order for clothing and groceries issued.
