COUNTY COURT.

Report of the Proceedings of the September Session.

In the matter of the report and acceptance of the improvement of the Molalla river by Sidney Smyth; report accepted and warrant ordered drawn for amount.

In the matter of the petition of J. A. Wall for the keeping of William White, a county charge; petition allowed from August 1, 1897.

County warrant No. 26319 ordered cancelled, being a duplicate.

In the matter of report of viewers of damages in the change of the Linn road; report read and rejected by the court and J. K. Graham, J. L. Kruse and Phil Graves, new viewers appointed.

In the matter of the report of viewers of damages in the change of the Oregon City and Fred Mack road; report approved by the court.

In the matter of the cancellation of county warrants, No. 24933 for \$5 and warrant No. 24967 for \$5 in favor of E. P. Carter; warrants No. 22316, 22840, 22012 and 23148 for \$8 each in favor of S. E. Hillman; warrants No. 23847, 24342, 24638, 24834, 25254 and 25080 for \$3 each in favor of Louis Schultz; warrants No. 23848, 23129, 23349 and 22818 for \$8 each in favor of P. J. Ridings; warrants No. 25929, 26160 and 26375 for \$7 each in favor of Dr. L. White; warrant No. 33871 in favor of Jesse Hammer for \$7; warrants No. 27310 for \$4.80 in favor of C. Schubel; warrant No. 25541 for \$5 in favor of Alex Tice; and warrant No. 26386 for \$6 in favor of H. Straight, ordered cancelled by the court the papers for whom they were issued having either died or removed from the county.

In the matter of the cancellation of warrant No. 21647 for \$2.10 in favor of H. H. Carey; warrant No. 22341 for \$1.70 in favor of G. W. Stone, and warrant No. 10592 for \$1.50 in favor of George Berger ordered cancelled by the court; but if the parties for whom they were issued shall call for them the clerk was instructed to draw new warrants in their favor.

Mrs. Caroline Debauw, a pauper, was allowed \$10 per month.

The allowance of Len Jones and family, county charges, was raised from \$14 to \$20 per month for an indefinite period.

In the matter of Sidney Smyth's bill laid over until February term, 1898; ordered that bill be paid on that date.

Petition for relief and maintenance of Sarah Shelton, granted, and \$8 a month allowed.

All bids for the care and nursing of county patients rejected without being opened.

In the matter of the contingent fund; \$100 allowed.

In the matter of the keeping of Chas. Cutting, a county charge; the allowance of \$8 per month drawn in favor of H. Straight discontinued and Mrs. Lydia Winesett allowed \$20 for keeping said Cutting for the month of September.

Petition of the board of equalization for an extension of time, granted until October 18, 1897.

In the matter of one Lewis, colored, for county aid; orders given on stores.

In the matter of the petition of C. Thompson for the payment of delinquent taxes without costs added; petition granted.

In the matter of the payment of claims filed against the county, the court having examined them and being fully advised in the matter, the clerk was ordered to draw warrants upon the general fund in payment of said claims as follows:
