A New Road Proposed.

A movement is now on foot to build a wagon road, beginning at lower Main street at the Cataract engine house, to pass under the Southern Pacific track opposite the flour mills, extend up the bluff at a seven per cent grade, and to continue on a direct line to New Era. This is a road that should interest every body, as a city's prosperity depends on the quantity and quality of her commercial highways, and this city suffers more from poor roads than any community in Oregon.

Two advantages are to be gained from this new road, if the people will encourage its erection, 1st the distance to New Era will be lessened one fourth and 2nd, trains and screening engines will never be encountered, to frighten timid horses and therefore endanger the lives of people, as at present, for the road will be built a safe distance away.
