COUNTY TEACHERS' ASSOCIATION.

A Very Successful Meeting Held At Damascus last Saturday.

The Clackamas County Teachers' Association held a very interesting meeting at Damascus Saturday, September 23, 1898. This was the first regular meeting since June, and was quite enthusiastic. Supt. H. S. Strange was unfortunately too ill to attend, so the vice-president, T. J. Gary, occupied the presidential chair.

The minutes of the last meeting as prepared by the secretary, Fannie G. Porter, were read and approved.

The program was opened by singing "America," Miss Enla Strange presiding at the organ.

H. M. Stahlaker, of Sunnyside school gave an interesting talk on "School Management." The subject was discussed at some length by F. W. Boland, Mr. Tallman, Herbert Lee, Fannie G. Porter and Mrs. O. P. Hedge. The speakers emphasized the desirability of governing a school without seeming to do so; the necessity of arousing personal pride among pupils, and cultivating right principles.

"Composition" was originally assigned to Miss Emma Stuehler, of Clackamas, but as she was absent, the subject was introduced by Miss Jennie E. Rowen and discussed by Miss Louise Boehlke, A. C. Strange, T. J. Gary and H. S. Gibson.

Dinner was then announced and it is hardly necessary to state that the Association adjourned in a body, to Mr. Denboer's where a bountiful repast was earnestly discussed.

Afternoon Session.

Called to order at 1:30 by the vice-president, T. J. Gary. The Association sang "Kind Words" with Miss Hawley as organist.

It was decided to hold the next regular meeting at Carus, the last Saturday in October. O. H. Byland, Jennie E. Rowen and Louise Boehlke were asked to prepare a suitable program for the occasion.

N. W. Boland gave an excellent address on "History." He would teach the history of the past and the history of today, at the same time. He was followed by Mr. Lee, of Multnomah county.

"Civil Government" was the subject assigned to A. C. Strange, and as usual, his address was both interesting and instructive. The proper place to begin the study of Civil Government is in the

home but unfortunately, this is not always done. The first lesson which a child should be taught is to respect the rights of others. He should be made to understand that if he transgresses, punishment will inevitably follow.

Arta McLaughlin, who is a member of the Oregon Volunteers, was present and was called upon for a talk on "Army Life." He related many of his experiences and graphically described "Camp Life." He spoke of the museum at San Francisco, the Academy of Sciences, the government mint and especially the iron works where the glorious battleship Oregon was built. Being interested in school work, he of course visited several of the San Francisco schools, but thinks the Oregon schools are fully as good.

Mr. Gibson introduced a resolution thanking the people of Damascus for their kind and courteous treatment of the Association, which was unanimously adopted.

The attendance at this meeting was quite good.

On motion the Association adjourned to meet again at Carus, October 29, 1898.
