

Marion county candidates are canvassing the county in joint debate. The republican legislative ticket has a conceded walk over.

Astoria for the first time in the history of the port has established a quarantine of vessels. It relates particularly to Chinese passengers.

Tuesday, May 22.

Portland is to furnish most of the Alaska army supply. Got \$250,000 worth of orders. Portland firms distance Seattle and Tacoma competitors in bidding on government contracts.

Ex-Senator Nathaniel P. Hill passed out of life. He was one of the wealthiest men in Colorado.

Secretary Long is believed to be in the best position to draw the prize for second place on the republican national ticket. If it must go to the west, Henderson, of Iowa, has big support, Payne next.

Miss Ida Foss of Hood River was shot and instantly killed by Benjamin Wagnitz. Murderer became remorseful after crime and kills himself with same weapon.

Wednesday, May 23.

Deadlock broken in the Methodist general conference at Chicago and Hamilton and Moore are elected bishops.

Boers determine to fight to a finish. The Dutch spirit is rising. Roberts' main army is moving and is expected to cross the Vaal river this week.

President McKinley refuses to intervene in behalf of Boers, and points out the collapse of their waning hopes.

Two companies of insurgents surrender to Colonel Licum at Tarlac. They included a major, captain, four lieutenants 163 men and 168 rifles and ammunition.

Senate will take up the Clark Senatorial case next Wednesday.

Roberts' army has reached the frontier of the Transvaal.

One hundred vessels are ready to sail to Cape Nome with 15000 passengers.

Sundry civil bill has \$250,000 for the Columbia jetty as reported to the senate.

Neely, the postal en-bazzer, will be taken to Cuba.

Schwan says the Tagal war is about broken.

The Methodist conference abolishes the time limit a minister can serve in one place.

Sound money democrats are against Bryan.

The business portion of Lakeview is burned, loss \$350,000.

In the storm Wednesday many fishing boats capsized and four men drowned at Astoria.
