MACAND ROOSEVELT For President and Vice-President of the United States. CHINA AGAINST THE WHOLE WORLD Fires on Foreign Legations and Breaks Peace With all Other Nations.

PHILADELPHIA, June 21.—For the first time in the history of the nation, two candidates have received the nomination for president and vice-president of the United States by acclamation.

LONDON, June 18.—China declared war against the world when the Taku forts opened fire upon the international fleet. The accounts of what took place are still unsatisfactory.

The unofficial narratives coming by way of Shanghai vary and bear evidence of supplementing the main facts with guess work. One dispatch says that the Yorktown participated in the bombardment.

LONDON, June 20, 3 a. m.—The Russian relieving force arrived outside of Pekin this morning and immediately began to attack the city on two sides, employing numerous artillery.
