

IN THE CIRCUIT COURT.

Opening Of the April Term With a Big Divorce Docket.

The Circuit Court opened last Monday morning with Judge McBride on the bench. The fact that 57 divorce cases awaited adjudication did not seem to bother the court very much.

In the appeal from the county board in relation to the Fanton road, the court ordered the papers in the case brought before him for review.

The arguments of counsel in the litigation between the Southern Pacific Railway company and the electric street railway company were heard Tuesday afternoon.

KILLING IN CROOK COUNTY.

D. L. Bruner, of Molalla, Takes the Life of Thomas O'Reilly.

D. L. Bruner, who shot and killed Thomas O'Reilly April 4 near Ashwood in Black rock gulch, is a son of Frank Bruner, of Molalla.

The facts are difficult to obtain, owing to the isolation of the tragedy. The Primeville Land and Live Stock company owns several bands of sheep.

As the testimony before the coroner's jury was given by Creegan, the only eye witness to the killing, it is said that it was rather one sided on account of Creegan and O'Reilly being close friends and partners in business.

ROAD SUPERVISOR RESIGNS.

The Rules governing the eighth grade examinations have been amended as follows:— Rule 7. The examination shall be held in such places in the county as the Superintendent may designate.

Rule 15. The county school superintendent shall grade the papers, or call to his assistance one or more teachers of his county to assist in grading them; provided, that the county school superintendent shall not grade papers of any applicant until such applicant's teacher has certified, in writing, to the superintendent that such applicant has completed all the branches prescribed in the State Course of Study.

Rule 19. Pupils who shall reach an average of 80 per cent in all branches, and shall not fall below 70 in any one branch, will be considered as having successfully passed the examination; provided, that when an applicant has failed in not more than two branches he shall be allowed to re-write in on the subjects in which he failed, at the following examination, and shall then, if he has secured the required percentage, receive an eighth grade diploma in accordance with the results of the two examinations.

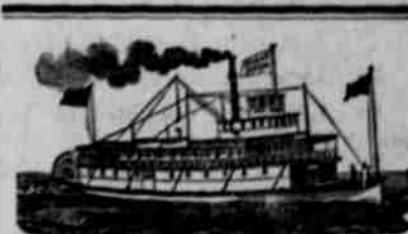
