THE LOCAL NEWS.

JUNIOR SOCIABLE.—The Junior society of the Baptist church under supervision of Mrs. Thomas Gault, will give an entertainment and sociable at the church on this Friday night.

CUSTODY OF THE FELLOW'S WILL.—On Monday Franklin T. Griffith and Gordon E. Hayes for proponents and C. D. Latourette and George C. Brownell for contestants, presented argument to T. F. Ryan, judge of probate court, in closing the contest of the will of Hiram Fellows, deceased.

WILL BRING WORK.—E. D. Olds has filed his contract bond to Clackamas county for the construction of Sucker creek bridge, which has been accepted

by the county board of commissioners and work will begin forthwith. The bridge will be 195 feet in length, 16 feet wide with a 75-foot span over the stream, covered with shingle, roof and sides enclosed. The structure is designed to be substantial and will be a valuable improvement to the Aurora and Oswego road. It must be completed by July 20, 1901.

DAMASCUS PICNIC.—The Modern Woodmen will hold a picnic at Damascus on the Fourth of July, at which time that section of the country expect to hold one of the greatest celebrations ever held in the county.

CONVENTION OF CHRISTIAN ENDEAVOR.—The State Convention of Christian Endeavor meets at Salem, May 16, continuing over the following Sunday. Entertainment will be provided for two delegates from each of the Young People's societies of Oregon City.

OFF FOR THE MINES.—M. M. Schenck and D. A. Williams started Tuesday morning for the mines in Southern Oregon. They each held good positions in the Willamette Pulp and Paper Mills and voluntarily suspended work to go prospecting, and take a rest from the confinement of the mill.

BRAKEMAN SEVERELY INJURED.—Woods Young, brakeman on the Albany local train was severely injured about the head and body on Wednesday morning while the north and south bound passenger trains were passing at the Oregon City depot.

DEFICIENCY IN SCHOOL TAXES.—For some time past the revenue for school purposes in Clackamas county has been constantly diminishing and upon investigation of the matter, Superintendent Zinser has discovered that a large amount of taxable property is sold each year to Clackamas county which satisfies the specific claim of the county against the property but does not thereby liquidate the school tax without further appropriations from the county.

COUNCILMAN FRANCIS BADLY INJURED.—On Wednesday morning about 9 o'clock Councilman S. D. Francis was accidentally caught in a belt at the Willamette Paper mills and before assistance could reach him was carried into the pulley and shafting, almost severing both ears, breaking one arm in two places and fracturing several ribs besides internal injuries, likely to prove fatal.

ADJUSTING SCHOOL DISTRICT BOUNDARIES.—Prof. J. C. Zinser and members of the School District Boundary Board have discovered that a large area of taxable property and land in Clackamas county has heretofore not been assessed for school purposes for the reason that it has not been included in any school district. The board will adjust the matter so that hereafter all property benefitted thereby shall be included in some district and the school fund thereby be enlarged to that extent.

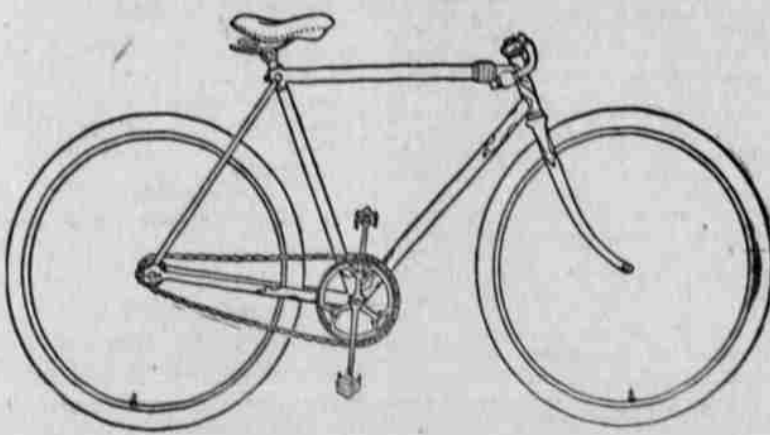
