NEW COUNTY BRIDGE. To be Built Across the Molalla River Between Barlow and Canby.

County Commissioners Killen, Morton and Lewellin went to Barlow Tuesday to locate the new bridge soon to be constructed across the Molalla river between Canby and Barlow.

Edward Olds, of West Oregon City, who is just finishing the construction of a bridge at Oswego, is drawing up the plans and specifications for the Molalla bridge, which will be a wooden Howe Truss, double span, 352 feet long, the north span being 172 feet and the south span 180 feet.

STILL IN DOUBT. But the Street Light Question Will be Settled Next Week.

The committee on streets and public property are in communication with the Portland General Electric company regarding the street lighting question, but as yet nothing definite is known.

The council has received a proposition from J. M. Hamilton, of Yreka, Cal., to supply arc lights to the city at the rate of \$5.50 per month and 16 candle power incandescents for 55 cents, provided the city will grant him the exclusive pole privilege.
