

Notice to Bridge Builders.

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the county surveyor of Clackamas county, Oregon, at his office in the county court house, in Oregon City, until July 6, 1901, at 2 o'clock p. m. of that day, to build a bridge across the Molalla river at the site selected for said bridge, near the O. & C. R. R. bridge, between Canby and Barlow.

Said bridge must be constructed in strict accordance with the plans and specifications for such bridge, on file in the office of the county surveyor. Each bidder shall be required to deposit with his bid five per cent of the amount of such bid, which shall be forfeited to the county in case the award is made to him and if he fails, neglects or refuses for the period of two days after such award is made to enter into the contract and file his bond in the manner required by and to the satisfaction of the board of county commissioners.

The board of county commissioners reserve the right to reject any and all bids.

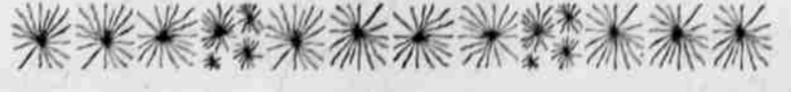
