COMMISSIONS ON SOLICITING ALMS.

What are the ethics of eleemosynary solicitation? Like the etiquette of private cars, this question is entirely modern, and there is nothing in the department books regarding it.

The State Board of Agriculture are making some wonderful improvements at the state fair grounds, and old timers will hardly recognize the place when they attend Oregon's greatest fair this fall.

The horse abattoir at Linnton has started up and promises to run indefinitely. About 800 ponies have already been sent in and it is probable that 10,000 will be slaughtered this year.

This estimate of the engineers for rivers and harbors for the country is something like three hundred millions for the coming year while the river and harbor committee say that the limit of appropriations is something like fifty millions for the country.

The Schley-Sampson controversy is to be aired by an official investigation by the government. This is brought on by charges in the new naval building at Annapolis against Schley.
